Pulaski Theatre, founded in downtown Pulaski, Virginia in 1911, served as a vital part of the area's economy – first as a vaudeville house and later as a movie theatre. After thriving in the 1950s and 1960s, the Theatre experienced decline and, sadly, closed to the public in 1991.

THE FRIENDS OF PULASKI THEATRE

The Friends of the Pulaski Theatre is a volunteer, non-profit organization incorporated in 1993 for the sole purpose of restoring and returning the Theatre to operation. The Friends group acquired the Theatre in 1999 through a deed of gift from the Pulaski County Board of Supervisors and saved it from demolition.



PULASKI THEATRE RESTORATION

After the Theatre closed to the public, the building fell into serious disrepair. Over the past few years, the Friends of the Pulaski Theatre have worked to raise funds to restore the Theatre. Significant progress has been made, financed primarily through the generosity of individual and corporate donors, private foundations and local and State government. Restoration completion is now within reach, but additional funds are urgently needed to turn what once was only a dream into reality.
